LYRICS AND RHYME

- The lyrics evoke an emotional response from the listener or reader relevant to the theme
- The lyrics are singable and memorable
- The lyrics have an identifiable rhyme scheme or pattern

RHYTHM

- The rhythm adds to the emotional impact of the poem relevant to the theme
- The rhythm keeps the listener/reader interested and engaged
- The rhythm and lyrics fit together in a cohesive way

ORIGINALITY

- The poem expresses the theme in a new or fresh way
- The poem is memorable
- The poem is the original work of the student

Song Criteria

SONG STRUCTURE AND COMPOSITION

- The song is relevant to the Mathematics theme
- The song has clearly identifiable sections, verse, chorus, etc.
- The song is between 2 to 5 minutes

LYRICS

- The lyrics evoke an emotional response from the listener relevant to the theme
- The lyrics are singable and memorable
- The lyrics have an identifiable rhyme scheme or pattern

MUSIC & MELODY

- The music and melody adds to the emotional impact of the song
- The music keeps the listener interested and engaged
- The music and lyrics fit together in a cohesive way

ORIGINALITY

- The song expresses the theme in a new or fresh way
- The song is memorable
- The song is the original work of the student

Video criteria

VIDEO STRUCTURE AND COMPOSITION

- The video is relevant to the Mathematics theme
- The video has clearly identifiable sections, beginning, body and ending etc.
- The video is between 2 to 5 minutes

VISUALS

- The visuals evoke an emotional response from the viewer relevant to the theme
- The visuals are memorable
- The visuals have identifiable effects

MUSIC & AUDIO

- The music and audio adds to the emotional impact of the video
- The music and audio keeps the viewer interested and engaged
- The music and audio fit together in a cohesive way

ORIGINALITY

- The video expresses the theme in a new or fresh way
- The video is memorable
- The video is the original work of the student

POSTER STRUCTURE AND COMPOSITION

- The poster is relevant to the Mathematics theme
- The poster has clearly identifiable sections and not too overcrowded

- The design is memorable with points, lines, shapes, pattern, colour and texture
- The design is striking with contrast, emphasis, harmony, rhythm and movement

- The information adds to the emotional impact of the poster relevant to the theme
- The information keeps the viewer interested and engaged
- All information fit together in a cohesive way
