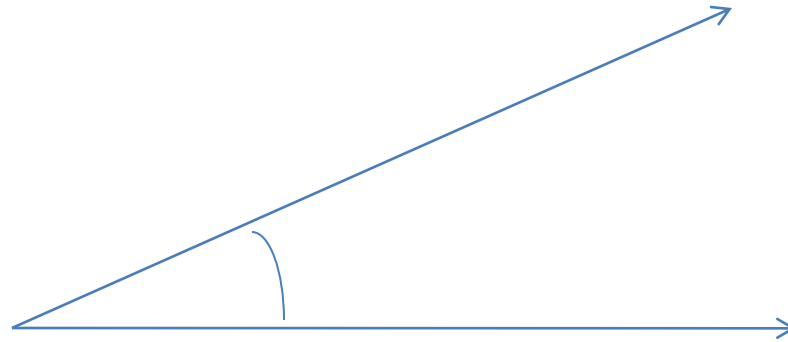
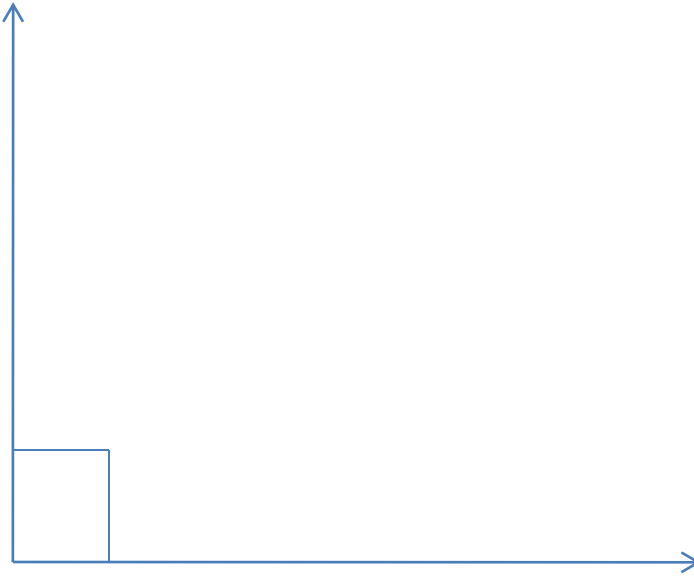


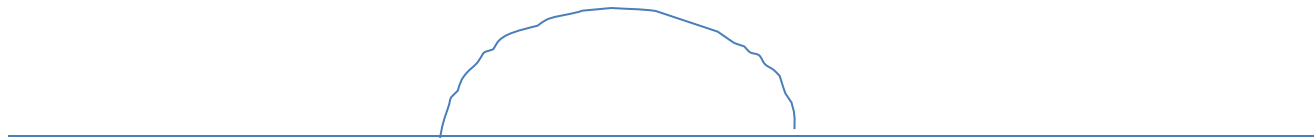
Acute Angle: An angle measuring less than 90 degrees and greater than zero degrees.



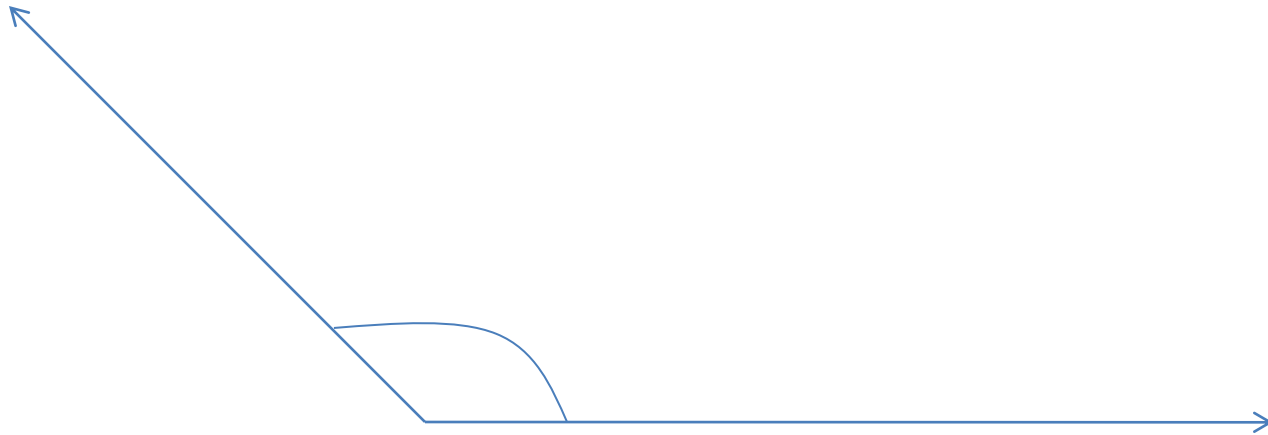
Right Angle: An angle measuring 90 degrees .



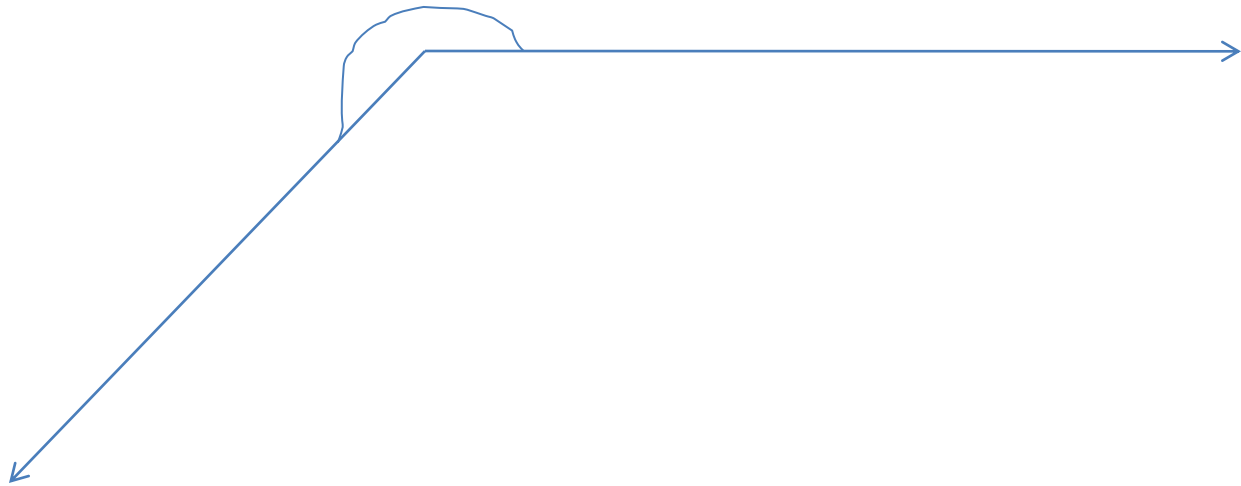
Straight Angle: An angle measuring 180 degrees



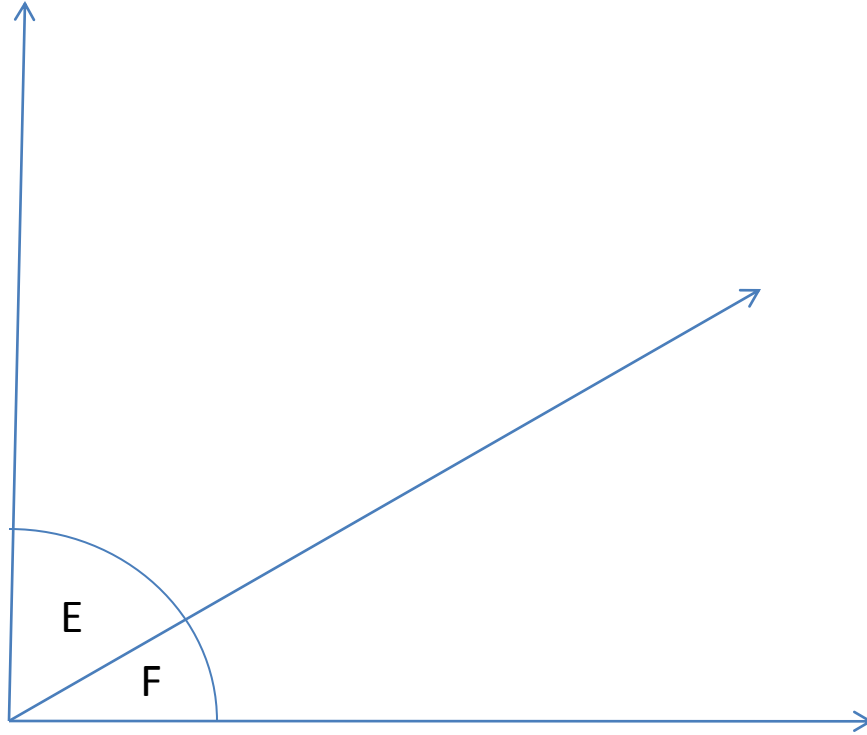
Obtuse Angle: An angle measuring greater than 90 degrees and less than 180 degrees



Reflex Angle: An angle measuring greater than 180 degrees and less than 360 degrees



Two angles are **complementary angles** if their sum is equal to 90 degrees. Note angle E and F equal to 90 degrees



Two angles are supplementary angles if their sum is equal to 180 degrees. Note angles G and H are supplementary angles
